

A Race to Win

Suitable age: Preschool up

Prior knowledge required: Alphabet Sounds

Format: PDF

Pages: 8

Colour/Black and White: Colour

A great game consisting of 24 double-sided cards. This game gives children practice at small words whilst revising their alphabet sounds.

The game has been designed for two or more players.

As an example of how this game is played, Mike reads the word on the back of his card: "camp". Once he has read the word Mike places the card into the middle of the group.

It is then a race between all of the other children to look through their cards to see if a) they have a camp card; and then b) to be the first child to put the card down.

The winning child can then flip over their camp card and read the word on the back e.g. "man". The game continues in the same manner until one child gets rid of all of their cards. This child will be the winner.
