

Flipping Cards - Blending/Reading - File 1

Suitable age: Preschool up
Prior knowledge required: None
Format: PDF
Pages: 9
Colour/Black and White: Colour

This resource is made up of 48 different cards.

Each page (which contains twelve cards) focus on words made up from particular alphabet sounds. The first twelve words use only the sounds: c, a, t, d, o, g and f. The second set of words introduce the sounds: x, v, n, z and i, but they will also use many of the sounds covered in the first set of words. Each set will continue in the same way, introducing new sounds, but also covering many of the previous sounds.

The sounds covered in this resource are: c, a, t, d, o, g, f, x, v, n, z, i, p, w, e and r.

On one side of the card is a word and on the other side its matching picture.

The child simply reads the word then flips over the card to see the picture to confirm. Alternatively, the child can use these cards to practice segmenting (spelling) by identifying the picture, spelling the word and then confirming it by flipping the card over to see the written word.
