This set contains 27 cards focusing on different alphabet sounds. The child will be learning to isolate the initial sound and then practice writing the letter next to the object.


There is an option of two different sounds for the letter 'y'. Its initial sound: y-el-l-ow or its long vowel sound: c-r-y. If following the *A Step at a Time* curriculum we recommend the long vowel sound.


Included with these cards is a 'Correct Letter Formation Chart' which gives examples of the correct formation of the lowercase letters.
