Matching Objects/Animals to Initial Sound









Suitable age: Preschool up










Student Instructions: For the letters given below, you need to find three cards which show an animal or object starting with that initial sound. The easiest way to play this game (for a beginner) is to identify the object/animal on the card and then place it in the correct initial sound row. Alternatively, a slightly harder version of this game can be played by searching through all of the object/animal cards until you find three that start with the 'o' sound and so on. The yellow star on the picture of the fox, fox and box is to remind the child to listen to the last sound not the initial sound.
