

# Initial Sound Activities - Seven Different Activities

This resource offers seven interactive activities where the child will be learning to isolate initial sounds. Each activity has interactive pieces.

These activities can be used to raise an awareness of spoken sounds and also to teach the alphabet sounds. Perfect for absolute beginners. Each of these activities are different in order to keep the child's interest.

**Activity 1:** v o f g. Student Instructions: For each of the pictures you need to identify and find the correct sound card. Space is provided under each picture for the letter.

**Activity 2:** c t a d. Student Instructions: Starting at 'c' you need to decide whether the picture within the box begins with the initial sound 'c'. If it does, you should put a tick card over the square. If it doesn't, the cross card should be used. Continue in the same way with the rest of the boxes.

**Activity 3:** t d v g. Student Instructions: For each of the pictures you need to identify and find the correct sound card. Space is provided under each picture for the letter.

**Activity 4:** c t a d. Student Instructions: Starting at 'c' you need to decide whether the picture within the box begins with the initial sound 'c'. If it does, you should put a tick card over the square. If it doesn't, the cross card should be used. Continue in the same way with the rest of the boxes.

**Activity 5:** d a c t. Student Instructions: Starting at 'd' you need to decide whether the picture within the box begins with the initial sound 'd'. If it does, you should put a tick card over the square. If it doesn't, the cross card should be used. Continue in the same way with the rest of the boxes.

**Activity 6:** t d v g. Student Instructions: For each of the pictures you need to identify and find the correct sound card. Space is provided under each picture for the letter.

**Activity 7:** c t a d. Student Instructions: Starting at 'c' you need to decide whether the picture within the box begins with the initial sound 'c'. If it does, you should put a tick card over the square. If it doesn't, the cross card should be used. Continue in the same way with the rest of the boxes.
