

# Small Sentences - File 1

**Suitable age:** Preschool up

**Prior knowledge required:** Alphabet sounds

**Format:** PDF

**Pages:** 9

**Colour/Black and White:** Colour

There are eight different sentence matching sets which introduce oo, ee, sh, ch, th, el and ar and revise the alphabet sounds. Each sentence set will also focus on certain high frequency words (HFWs).

The high frequency words focused on in this file are: look, a, is, find, go, has, that, this, I, must, see, in, on, he, at, my and can.

What is special about these sentence sets is that whilst they continue to introduce a new sound each time, they will also revise the sounds introduced in the previous sets. For your information, below is a table of all of the sounds/spellings and the order they are introduced.









These sentences have been designed to help the child become more fluent in their reading.




Each activity has approximately nine different sentences to read. The objective is for the child to read the sentences and then find the matching/ corresponding picture. There are some sentences that add a little humour.
