

The Small Sentence Game

Suitable age: Preschool up

Prior knowledge required: Alphabet Sounds

Format: PDF

This resource contains a wonderful game consisting of 32 double-sided cards. It really is great fun and perhaps most importantly, it gives children practice at small sentences and revises their alphabet sounds.

The game has been designed for three or more players (although you can play it with just two if you choose to, it just isn't quite as much fun).

As an example of how this game is played, Billy reads the sentence on the back of his card: "I am a hen". Once he has read the sentence Billy places the card into the middle of the group.

It is then a race between all of the other children to look through their cards to see if a) they have a hen card; and then b) to be the first child to put the card down.

The winning child can then flip over their hen card and read the sentence on the back e.g. "A fat cat". The game continues in the same manner until one child gets rid of all of their cards. This child will be the winner.
